- The inaugural full day in person training in Kenya in 2019
- A full day virtual training program in 2021
- 19 dedicated webinars delivered during 2023 and 2025
- 40+ interdisciplinary subject matter experts and patients involved
- Informative lectures, engaging case discussions, and practical demonstrations



Written commitment from participants to share the knowledge and apply their learning in the clinical setting

70% of clinicians shared a brochure with patients on sexual sideeffects and rehabilitation




100% of clinicians included questions about sexual concerns in the routine appointments



85% of clinicians invited partners to discuss sexual side-effects



70% of clinicians identified sexual health support in the community
