Specifically, the fellowship will provide expert and dedicated training in the diagnosis and management of male and female sexual dysfunction, male infertility, and prosthetic urology utilizing the most modern diagnostic tests and surgical techniques. We also trained in transgender care and surgery Sexual and Reproductive Medicine, and urinary incontinence clinic 2-3 days a week. All clinical activities will directly supervise by the responsible attending.
