<b>Fellowship Overview (300 words)</b>	<p>San Diego Sexual Medicine (SDSM) and Kaiser Permanente (KP) offer a unique, one-year combined clinical fellowship in Sexual Medicine/Prosthetic Urology/Male Infertility. Irwin Goldstein, MD and Eugene Rhee, MD MBA, offer the opportunity to learn management of overall sexual dysfunction for both men and women, prosthetic urology, reconstructive urology, minimally invasive surgery (MIS) for BPH, and infertility in men. Exposure includes multiple health care environments: academic, private practice, VA, and HMO. While with Dr. Goldstein the fellow will operate at Alvarado Hospital for all sexual medicine procedures <del>and at the VA Hospital where urology residents are trained on prosthetics</del>. At KP, the fellow will operate with Dr. Rhee and his partners at all KP affiliated surgical centers. The fellow will be expected to attend journal club, urology and sexual medicine conferences at KP, Alvarado Hospital, UCSD, San Diego Urologic Society and present at various urology/sexual medicine rounds throughout the year. The fellow will submit abstracts and attend the annual meetings of the Sexual Medicine Society of North America, the Society of Urologic Prosthetic Surgeons, the International Society for the Study of Women’s Sexual Health (ISSWSH), and the American Urological Association, as well as a course in women’s sexual health sponsored by ISSWSH. The fellow will also be expected to participate in clinical research at SDSM. Upon completion, the fellow will have an</p>

	<p>understanding of the continuum of care approach from clinic to surgery of both male and female sexual dysfunction, incontinence, reconstructive urology, MIS for BPH, and male infertility. This includes history taking, physical examination, laboratory tests and in office diagnostic procedures including how to perform tests and interpret results. Innovation with Drs. Goldstein and Rhee is the theme of this uniquely collaborative fellowship with opportunities in cutting edge surgery, clinical trials, population-based medicine, telemedicine encounters and shared medical appointments.</p>
<p><b>Research Focus (300 words)</b></p>	<p>Clinical research involves an opportunity to perform both prospective and retrospective clinical research in such areas as testosterone in women, 5 alpha reductase inhibitor side effects, thermography, regenerative medicine. It is expected that research projects will lead to presentations at national and/or international meetings, as well as publications. It is up to the fellow how much time is dedicated to this endeavor.</p>
